

GOOD NEIGHBOUR POLICY STATEMENT

It is the clearly defined intent of our Management Team on all live projects to ensure the assessment of the project's likely impact upon its neighbours and the neighbouring environment. We will assist the Principal Contractor's Project Director to establish a team who will deal directly with this on-going requirement. If we are acting as the Principal Contractor, we will expect the support of our supply chain. We will register our projects with the CCS.

We shall undertake to do all that is necessary in our duty of care to others by identifying any operations necessary to the project which may result in an impact regarding:

- noise
- dust
- vibration
- waste
- public protection - vehicle and pedestrian interface
- social issues - verbal abuse, obscenities, protection of ethnic minorities, etc.

The overall objective is to eliminate/reduce these impacts so far as is reasonably practicable.

We shall create and nurture good relations with project neighbours by establishing clearly defined routes and methods of communication and liaison in assistance with all parties and CDM duty holders.

This policy shall be conveyed to all person affected by it or required to implement its intent.

This shall be achieved by team briefings and site safety induction.

Project specific newsletters will be compiled and sent to local businesses and residents.

The policy shall be reviewed in line with our Environmental Policy.

This policy applies to all employees of Alcema & Alcema Fire Limited.
